Free On Site Inspection

Provide us with your property address and we will arrange for one of our experienced team members to inspect your property and confirm if a granny flat can be built via a Complying Development Certificate (CDC) or Development Application (DA).



Select Your Design

Quotation

Customer Acceptance

It's time to begin the design and approval phase! This phase includes signing the pre-construction agreement and paying the design deposit to kick start the process.



Design Process

Selection Process

Contract

Prior to commencement of work a construction deposit is required along with the submission of Home Owners Warranty insurance and the signing of a BC4 Master Builders Contract.



Approval

Your Approval Coordinator will prepare and submit your application to either our private certifier or your local council for approval. Our team will liaise with all other professionals and authorities and complete all applications obtain authority certificates on your behalf including BASIX. The balance of the design fee is due once the application is submitted for approval.



Construction

Once your contract has been signed our team will then issue a start date. From the start date, the construction of the granny flat will be completed in approximately 12-14 weeks depending upon the complexity of the design.



Practical Completion

On completion you will be invited to a site meeting with one of our Directors to review the job and identify if any final works or items need to be addressed. It is at this time that your final invoice is issued.
